In December, 20% "Others" included nine candidates who later withdrew or were removed from the ballot. Election results, Board of Election Commissioners, Feb 23.

Poll Estimate Error: One half the difference between the election margin and poll margin for the top two candidates. That difference - if added to one candidate and subtracted from the other - would exactly match the election margin. This is the only error measure comparable to sample margin of error and the method used by the National Council on Public Polls since 1997.
